Course Objectives

Welcome to the Art and Design programme at Rochester Independent College, a creative haven for students aged 12-15 who are passionate about expressing themselves through art. Our programme is designed to inspire and nurture young artists by providing a diverse range of artistic experiences. Whether you're interested in drawing, painting, sculpture, or digital design, this course offers the perfect opportunity to explore your creativity, develop your skills, and discover your unique artistic voice.

Module 1

Drawing and Painting Fundamentals

Begin with the basics of drawing and painting, exploring techniques and materials like pencils, charcoal, watercolours, and acrylics, while developing observational skills and translating your vision onto paper or canvas through guided exercises and projects.

Module 2

Exploring 3D Art

Step into the world of 3D art by working with materials like clay, plaster, and found objects to create sculptures and installations, learning about form, texture, and space, and expressing your ideas in three dimensions with creativity and innovation.

Module 3

Introduction to Digital Design

Explore the intersection of art and technology through digital design, learning to use basic digital tools and software to create digital paintings and graphic designs, and building a portfolio that showcases your creativity and technical skills.



Previous projects include:

Urban Landscapes: A Study in Contrast and Composition

A project where students created a series of digital illustrations exploring the juxtaposition of nature and cityscapes, focusing on composition, colour theory, and thematic depth.

This project allows you to bring your artistic ideas to life, presenting your work to an audience while demonstrating your growth as an artist and your ability to communicate visually and verbally.



Time to Shine

For your Time to Shine project, you will create a unique and expressive piece of art or design reflecting the skills and concepts developed during the course. This project is your opportunity to showcase your creativity, technical ability, and personal artistic vision. Whether you choose to produce a painting, digital artwork, graphic design, or mixed-media installation, your project will culminate in a presentation where you'll discuss your process, inspiration, and the message behind your work.
