Course Objectives

Welcome to Future Artists, a creative journey designed for aspiring young artists aged 11-15. At Canford School, we believe that everyone has a unique artistic voice waiting to be discovered. This course invites you to explore a wide range of artistic techniques and mediums, from drawing and painting to sculpture and digital art. Whether you're an experienced artist or just starting out, Future Artists will help you express your creativity and develop your artistic skills in a fun and supportive environment.

Module 1

Exploring Drawing and Painting

Dive into drawing and painting by learning sketching, shading, and colour theory, experimenting with materials like pencils, watercolours, and acrylics, and developing your own artistic style through guided practice and creative projects.

Module 2

Discovering 3D Art and Sculpture

Explore the world of 3D art and sculpture by working with materials like clay, wire, and found objects to create sculptures, learning principles of form, texture, and space, and expressing your ideas in three dimensions.

Module 3

Introduction to Digital Art

Step into digital art by learning to use basic digital tools and software for creating artworks, exploring digital painting and graphic design, and combining traditional techniques with digital innovation.



Previous projects include:

A Journey Through Color: An Exploration of Abstract Painting

A project where the student created a series of abstract paintings, experimenting with color theory and different techniques to convey emotion and movement.

This project invites you to push the boundaries of your creativity, apply what you've learned, and present a piece that truly represents your artistic identity.



Time to Shine

For your Time to Shine project, you will create an original piece of art or design that reflects your personal vision and the techniques you've mastered during the course. This project will culminate in an exhibition where you will present your work, discuss your creative process, and receive feedback from your peers and instructors. It's a chance to showcase your creativity, technical skills, and unique artistic voice.
