Question to Answer:

Tell us about a time when you showed a quality or skill that helped others? What happened, and how did your actions make a difference?

Introduction (Start Here):

Begin by saying your name, age, and where you're from.

Example: "My name is [Name], I'm [age], and I'm from [city/country]." Mention one thing about yourself, like a hobby, a subject you enjoy, or something you're proud of.

Example: "I enjoy [hobby or interest] because it helps me [reason]."

2 Share a Key Quality (Main Part):

Tell us about a time when you showed a quality or skill that helped others? What happened, and how did your actions make a difference?

Example: "A quality I've shown is [quality], I showed this because [reason or experience where you showed it]. My actions made a difference by..."

If you can, share a short story or example that shows this quality in action. Example: "For instance, I once [brief example], and it showed me how important [quality] is."

3 Relate It to SBC (Optional):

If you want, you can mention why you think this quality would be helpful at SBC.

4 Finish Strong (Conclusion):

Example: "I'm also excited to develop new skills and take part in the unique experiences SBC offers."
